TIMF programming covers all kinds of music genres including western(classical), world(ethnic), acoustic, non-popular, professional, orchestral, chamber/ensemble, virtuostic and contemporary. Festival constantly keeps its basis on westernized classical music, but at the same time, it opens a gate to different categories which can be classified into contemporary kinds and world music.

The challenging spirit of TIMF programming is derived from Isang Yun(1917~1995)'s challenging minds of composition. Being a world renowned composer born in Tongyeong, Isang Yun made prominent efforts to make east and west compatible, combined and/or collaborative, through hundreds of his valuable works in atonality and orientalism. Following his legacy, TIMF programming is based on below five rules;

1) keep studying and performing Isang Yun's works, 2) welcome musicians capable of Isang Yun's or other contemporary music, 3) prepare almost each different sets of instrumentation within one edition of festival, 4) provide chances to young and aspiring artists, and 5) follow up general trends of global music society.
